Level 3 Examiner Apprenticeship Application Process:

Send a cover letter, resume, updated logs and three letters of reference from industry leaders, one of which must be from a Course Provider, to the Executive Director.

Participate in an interview process. Be prepared to answer questions about technical and instructional skills and training, history leading in Class 3 conditions and Class 4 waters, i.e. current, tidal races, swell and surf, leadership and judgement, unusual incidents in career.

Steps to Achieving Level 3 Examiner Status:

- 1. Approval of apprenticeship application
- 2. Complete first exam/s as assist to a lead Examiner
- 3. Complete final exam as "lead," under supervision of Examiner. *Option to do three exams as apprentice: two as assist and one as final "lead"*
- 4. Submit two letters of reference from two Examiners, one must be from the Examiner supervising the exam the candidate was "lead" on. *Reference letters must include a recommendation from the referring Examiners based on Key Skills/ Knowledge Requirements for certification
- 5. All the apprenticeship requirements, plus
- 6. Design and complete one L3 Guide Exam as the "lead" Examiner, adapting the itinerary for conditions and contingencies to complete assessments in the 3-day time frame
- 7. Design, manage and assess scenarios in up to Class 3 conditions that are appropriately difficult for assessing Level 3 Guide outcomes (see GEMS for scenarios and outcomes and minimum and maximum conditions for L3 Guide Exams)
- 8. Comprehension of level of proficiency required for strokes, rescues, compass work, navigation assessment to a minimum Level 3 Guide standard
- 9. Deliver and evaluate L3 Guide Written and Oral exams
