

SKGABC Visual Representation of Days required for each guiding level

Example 1: In order to become a Level 2 Guide, you need to:

- Fulfill all requirements for an AOG (10 days of apprenticeship)
- Have an additional 20 days guiding overnight trips as an AOG

Example 2: in order to become a Guide Trainer, you need to:

- Fulfill all requirements to be a Level 3 guide
- Have an additional 40 days guiding overnight trips in Class 3 waters and 160 days guiding overnight trips as a Level 3 Guide
